

Call on Mr. Patrick Brown, Leader of Opposition, Ontario Legislature

The Consul General called on Mr. Patrick Brown, Leader of Opposition, Ontario Legislature this afternoon. Mr. Brown welcomed the Consul General to Toronto and expressed his full support to the Consulate's efforts for promotion of strong relations between Pakistan and Canada. He also outlined his Party's programme with focus on his position on issues relating to non-discrimination and equal rights for all Canadians. The Consul General thanked the Leader of the Opposition for receiving him at a short notice.

The Consul General outlined his priorities as the Consul General of Pakistan in Ontario which in addition to provision of consular services to Pakistan community included promotion of political and commercial relations between the two countries. He further stressed the need for greater cooperation between Pakistan and Canada on higher education, science and technology and innovation. The two countries can closely cooperate in their efforts to achieve Sustainable Development Goals (SDGs), he added. Mr. Brown agreed that closer cooperation between Pakistan and Canada was in the interest of the two countries. He fondly recalled his last visit to Pakistan and hoped to visit again in future.
